

PRIVACY STATEMENT

Dealer Security Solutions Inc, (DSS) a distributor and agent of Global Tracking Communications Inc. (GTC) are committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience with our products. This Statement of Privacy applies to the No Theft GPS, GTC and Dealership Tracking Web sites and governs data collection and usage of these sites. By using the DSS/GTC/Dealership Tracking websites, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

COLLECTION OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION - GTC, Inc. collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or any telephone number information collected for the operation of the service and to maintain quality of the service.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by GTC, Inc. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by GTC, Inc. for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the GTC Web site.

Please understand that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through GTC public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: GTC does not read any of your private online communications.

GTC encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from GTC so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. GTC is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the family of GTC Web sites.

USE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION GTC collects and uses your personal information to operate the GTC Web site and deliver the services you have requested.

GTC does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. GTC may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, GTC may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to. GTC and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

GTC does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

GTC Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on GTC or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of GTC; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of GTC or the public.

USE OF COOKIES The GTC Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize GTC pages, or register with GTC site or services, a cookie helps GTC to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same GTC Web site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the GTC features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION GTC secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. GTC secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Web sites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
